Dear Church Family:

As we walk together in this holy season of Lent in this Jubilee Year (every twenty-five years) declared by Pope Francis, we are "Pilgrims of Hope." Hope points to the future, but it is the actions we take today that will shape that future. Here in the



Archdiocese of Philadelphia, **Archbishop Nelson J. Perez** is calling us to a concerted process to renew the Church of Philadelphia over the next 20 years and invites everyone to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ. Currently, 83% of baptized Catholics are not participating in the sacramental life of the Church. The mission of the Church has always been to announce the resurrection and foster closer relationships with Jesus. This initiative aims to support the growth of the Church of Philadelphia in a way that best meets the needs of the souls entrusted to its pastoral care.

How can you help? One simple but very important thing you can do is to participate in the Disciple Maker's Index, a survey to better understand where we are as a faith community now so we can, together, more realistically shape our future.

This survey is very similar to the survey that was conducted in 2019 and again in 2022, but the number of respondents was far too low to provide any statistically significant results (41 parishioners from St. Charles and 35 parishioners from Sacred Heart). As we begin this pastoral process, we would like you to take a moment and see how we have grown and changed in the last three years. Please take 10 minutes to Disciple Maker Index survey help us track our progress and learn how we can support your discipleship better. The survey is anonymous and is being offered throughout the Archdiocese.

Here's what you need to know:

- This is a 10-15 minute survey that will be open from March 5th through April 10th, 2025.
- We are asking that every family member completes and submits their own survey. (Your feelings and responses may differ from your loved one, and that's OK.)
- The name of the Survey is called the Disciple Maker's Index. Please do not let the name of the survey deter you. The purpose of this survey is not to ask you to do more than what you already feel comfortable doing for the Church; it is simply a method to try to find out where we stand now as a faith community.
- The survey is completely anonymous and confidential! You can take it on line by visiting one of these sites or, if you prefer, there will be paper copies available in the exits of our churches.
