Fortunately, the empty convent on the Blessed Virgin Mary campus in Darby was available. During the time the BVM site was being renovated, the young women lived in a large home in Lansdowne. - New and gently used Baby Clothing (Sizes Newborn; 3-6; 6-9; 9-12; 18-24) No toddler sizes
- New Receiving Blankets
- Crib Sheets, new only
- New bibs
- Undershirts/Onesies (Sizes Newborn; 3-6; 6-9; 9-12; 18-24)
- Socks
- Laundry Detergent (Dreft or unscented)
- Infant strollers
- Humidifiers
- Infant rear-facing carseats
